### Transpo 2006 - SOG

Updates on the SOG have not been received from all. The deadline for the SOG is today. Regional maps are outdated, and a disclaimer will be placed

There will be a meeting on Wednesday, Nov 29 regarding FUSION. The meeting 2 weeks ago w/them did not go well, they did not seem to be thrilled about FUSION, and they weren't too clear as to why. They don't seem want to say why, what was clear was that they didn't like the name FUSION.

Steve's goal with FUSION is to have regional subcommittees so that essentially you control your own region. Still to be known as a statewide service.

All this information plus statistics, presentations, disseminate the guidelines will be available for TRANSPO. This was done previously and it was a hit.
